In 2017, The Royal Canadian Legion Headquarters (Dominion Command) established The Legion National Foundation, a charitable organization to enhance support for Veterans and their families across Canada. The Digital Poppy is the Foundation's signature Remembrance campaign.

What is the Digital Poppy ?

The Digital Poppy is an online symbol of Remembrance, inspired by the traditional poppy. It offers a meaningful, modern way to participate in a national act of honouring Canada's Veterans across all digital spaces.

The annual Digital Poppy Campaign is hosted on MyPoppy.ca.

The campaign runs from the last Friday of October through November 11th each year.

This year, the Remembrance period begins on **October 31st, 2025**.

Your Steps to Participate

1. Go to MyPoppy.ca.
2. Select "Create My Poppy."
3. Donate to support our Veterans - starting with \$3.
4. Personalize your Digital Poppy by adding a dedication.
5. Download and share it across your networks to promote Remembrance.





Every click, every share, keeps their memory alive.


